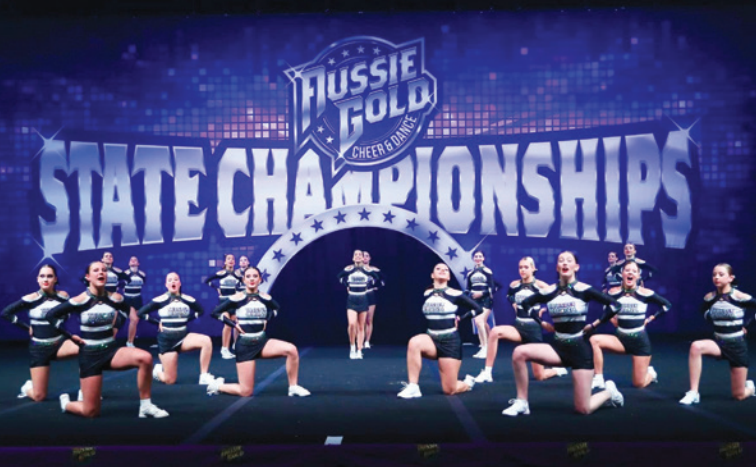


# Thunder Ohana Cheer & Dance
